

Bradley Academy Dress Code 2018-2019

The following dress code will be enforced by the faculty/staff. The school reserves the right to notify parents when student's dress is inappropriate. We will provide a change of clothes if one is available. If not, parents will be asked to bring appropriate clothes to school for their child.

Children are expected to come to school dressed appropriately. Clothing or accessories that disrupt learning and/or teaching are not considered acceptable dress. All shirts and pants should meet even when engaged in physical activity. When raising hands in the classroom, tummies should be covered.

The following items are considered inappropriate and unacceptable for school dress:

1. flip flops/slides (shoes must have a back for safety)
2. cut-off shorts or shirts
3. fishnet or see-through shirts
4. halter tops/midriff tops/tank tops/spaghetti-strap tops (sleeveless shirts must be at least 2" across the shoulders. Armpit area should be adequately covered.)
5. clothing with inappropriate logos, messages or pictures (alcoholic beverage logos, tobacco logos, profanity, etc.)
6. clothing with obvious holes or any holes above the knee on pants.
7. extremely short skirts, skorts, or shorts (should be to one's fingertips or longer than one's fingertips when standing straight.)
8. hats/caps or hoodies when worn indoors (except for the occasional spirit related event)
9. tights/leggings (must be worn with top that is fingertip length or under shorts/dress)
10. cleats
11. sagging pants (Loose fitting pants must be worn with a belt.)
12. bandanas/scarves
13. roller shoes ("Heelys")
14. wave caps
